<u>PREVIOUS COMMISSION ACTION RE: REPORT:</u> An interim report due 10/1/2015 on Strategic Planning that includes 1) documentation showing institutional approval for the plan; 2) documentation showing system approval for the plan; and 3) the final draft of the plan, including any revisions that derive from College or system review.

<u>ITEMS ADDRESSED IN REPORT:</u> The institution's report on the above topic was submitted to the office of the Commission on 9/28/2015.

<u>STAFF ANALYSIS:</u> Dakota College at Bottineau's (DCB) interim report on strategic planning is the third in a series of reports required by the Commission with respect to the institution's planning processes. The most recent report submission, in July 2015, contained a comprehensive draft of the institution's long-term plan but provided no information pertaining to plan approval at the College or system level.

The current interim report shows that the plan has received approval at all levels—institutional, affiliate and system. The report includes minutes from the DCB Staff Senate Meeting of September 21, 2015 which under the agenda item "New Business," shows unanimous support for the plan; and minutes from the August 20, 2015 DCB Faculty Senate, where the plan was again approved.

Information contained in the report also includes a letter from President Steven Shirley of Minot State University who serves as chief executive officer of both institutions, DCB being an affiliate of Minot State University. In his letter, Dr. Shirley states this: "I have thoroughly reviewed the plan and closely monitored the process used to establish the plan, and am in full support and offer my strongest endorsement of the 2015-2020 DCB Strategic Plan."
