Tuition & Fees: \$ 5,871.72

Canadian residents pay the in-state tuition rate which is \$ 4,180.72

Single: \$3,275 (Mead Hall & Gross Hall)

Double: \$2,507 (Mead Hall & Gross Hall)

Suite: \$2,759 (Milligan Hall)

Board:

\$ 3,538 (w/15 meals per week Monday-Friday)

\$ 3,979 (w/19 meals per week Monday-Sunday)

All students living in the residence halls are required to purchase a board contract. Rates have been established for board to begin with breakfast on the first day of orientation/registration for fall semester and on registration day for spring semester. During Christmas vacation the cafeteria will be closed. Special schedules will be posted for other holidays and vacation periods. Sack lunches are available for students whose class/work schedule conflict with cafeteria hours. Refunds are not given for missed meals. Students may not share food with non-contract students.

Books, Supplies & Miscellaneous (estimate):

Expenditures for textbooks, instructional materials and supplies must be figured into the total cost of attendance. This figure will vary depending upon a student's curriculum. Students must estimate the amount of money they will spend for such diverse items as recreation, clothing, transportation, etc. The amount will vary by individual student. The DCB Financial Aid Office uses this figure when estimating miscellaneous & instructional expenses for an academic year.

Health Insurance:

North Dakota State Board of Higher Education policy requires all international students to have health and accident insurance from the time of their registration until completion of studies. The cost for our international student health insurance has not been set for the 14-15 year at this time. Rates are also available for a student's spouse or for their entire family. Canadian students must provide proof of health and medical insurance coverage. Health insurance must be paid or proven prior to the start of classes during an enrolled semester. Credit card payments are accepted by contacting our Business Office at 701-228-5430.

Tax identification number information:

International students who receive any type of fee waiver or scholarship from Dakota College at Bottineau must obtain a tax identification number. Forms to obtain the tax identification number are available in the DCB Business Office. Students can complete the form when they arrive on campus.
