<b>a. Academic and Student Affairs</b>	Brooks	Bridges and Nursing orientation is this week. The CTE Showcase went very well in Bismarck last week.
<b>b. Administrative Affairs / Business Affairs</b>	Mock	Lisa is closing out grants for ECH and Center for Excellence.
<b>c. NJCAA Mon Dak / Athletics</b>	Davis	VB athletes arrived last week. There are 14 players. The first scrimmage is Wednesday, August 16. FB athletes arrive on Saturday. There are 92 on the list to arrive. Dan is expecting 75-80 players to commit. The practice fields are ready to go, although the high school field is still a concern. The weight room and fitness center updates are complete. There are 14-15 softball athletes coming this year.
<b>d. Distance Education Council/Distance Ed. and Academic Support Services</b>	O'Toole	There are 185 online students so far this fall, which is up from last year at this time. TRiO is submitting a proposal for work-study funds and is also looking into serving DCB students on the Minot Campus. One of the Land Management instructor positions has been filled. Kayla has weekly blackboard meetings. There are 115 dual credit packet applications received from 25 high schools and some home schools. It is expected to have about 35 high schools on board and another 100 more students registered.
