Chancellor's Cabinet / Dean's Update	Migler	<p>Attended a State Board retreat last week and shared the information with Council.</p> <p>State Board is conducting a mission study to identify the need of degree programs in ND. Results shared indicate that the program needs are being met. Although it is felt this is conflicting information as historically job openings remain in some fields, i.e. teaching, nursing.</p> <p>They are studying tuition, looking for direction on tuition waivers. Key points were addressed via reports from campuses.</p> <p>Shared services continues to be a focus. As time progresses there may be a period when the State Board sets expectations if there isn't any voluntary movement between colleges.</p> <p>Administrative Cost Study is being conducted with a goal to identify staffing ratio benchmarks for efficiencies.</p> <p>Predictive Analytics – timetable shared with the PAR initiative.</p>
