The **Associate of Arts (AA)/Associate of Science (AS)** at DCB offers students flexibility in planning their education. Students who are planning to continue their education toward a bachelor's degree or other academic programs beyond a two-year degree can explore many options from among all the classes and programs offered at DCB.

Why study to earn your Liberal Arts AA/AS degree?

The general education requirements build the foundation for further education. Students have the flexibility to build that foundation in a variety of areas. Students choose from many options to find the program they want to continue studying and to transfer to further their education.

Transfer choices

The AA/AS is a transfer degree for students planning to continue their education in a four-year program. Students who take this degree can find work in fields that require analytical, organizational, and software/internet skills.

General education requirements

This degree requires sixty-one credits to graduate. That total comes from communication, humanities, social sciences, math, science, computer science, and HPER (health, physical education, and recreation) courses chosen by the student in consultation with her or his advisor. When the required courses have been completed, students choose from many offerings available to meet the remaining credit hour requirements for graduation.

 Elective credits chosen from the ND:COMPSC, ND:MATH and ND:LABSC courses. Must include MATH 103 (or above), at least two lab sciences, and CSCI 101.


