As Director of Cardiac Rehab, I was responsible for working with patients who had suffered a heart attack or had heart surgery, to help them regain their strength and cardiovascular endurance. I also did many diagnostic tests, Cardiac stress tests, EKG's, Holter Monitors, and Pulmonary function tests.
