Tuition Waivers promote enrollment of a culturally diverse student body, including members of Indian tribes and economically disadvantaged students, for the benefit of all students and the academic community, to promote enrollment of graduate students and research, and for other purposes consistent with an institution's mission.

## **Application Procedures**

- 1) Complete the Institution Tuition Wavier form and submit the form along with your high school or college transcripts to Dakota College at Bottineau. The mailing and email addresses are at the end of this form.
- 2) Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 3) Complete the Dakota College at Bottineau application for admission and submit the application fee.

## Due to the limited number of awards, students who meet the eligibility requirements are not guaranteed an Institution Tuition Wavier.

## **Eligibility:**

- 1) Applicants must be accepted for admission at Dakota College at Bottineau.
- 2) Applicants must be degree-seeking students.

### **Academic considerations:**

- Past academic performance will be used in determining initial eligibility.
- Eligibility for renewal: student must have earned 24 semester hours per year and maintain good academic standing.

## Amount of waiver/duration:

- Waivers will not exceed the amount of tuition. Tuition waivers do not include fees, transportation costs, application fees, books, board, room or other costs of education.
- Generally, awards will be made for an academic year, but can be made for a longer or shorter duration.
- Recipients shall be limited to a maximum of two years as an undergraduate student.
- Waivers only apply to classes taken on the Dakota College at Bottineau campus, Minot campus, and Valley City State University campus. It does not cover distance education tuition, online courses and collaborative courses.
- Limited number of waivers available.
