# TRAVEL OR PAYMENT REIMBURSEMENT

The new Travel or Payment Reimbursement policy #806.1 has been published to our website. Click Here

Reimbursable travel expenses and per-diem are required to be uploaded no later than 60 days after the return from travel, or no later than 60 days after completion of the expense transaction if it did not involve travel.

Please work with your supervisor to make travel arrangements and coordination to minimize expenses. For example: carpool when registered for the same

training, room together when possible.

Effective August 16, 2025 reimbursement for the use of a personal vehicle will be at a reduced rate when a State Fleet vehicle is available.

When requesting mileage use the Transportation ID Drop down as follows:

- CINST for state reimbursement when vehicle is not available,
- MIL45 for state reimburse-

ment when using your personal vehicle and a State Fleet is available.

State Fleet vehicles are available at other State institutions and may be scheduled through DCB. All drivers must complete Defensive Driving Course within the past four years. Contact Denise in Physical Plant to schedule.
