Communication

Make sure Campus Connection has your current Emergency Contact Information. The Student and Exchange Visitor Program provides emergency information and guidance on maintaining your status at http://www.ice.gov/sevis/students/index.htm. You should contact your Consular office for emergency preparedness information and procedures.

Immigration Documents

Remember to keep your immigration documents in a safe place. These documents include: passport, visa, and I-20. Make sure to have photo identification (One Card, driver license, or other form of identification) with you at all times.

Emergency Evacuation Tips

- Remember to take important documents with you. These include the following:
- Passport (including visa, if applicable)
- Form I-20, "Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status"
- Financial records, checks, credit cards, and some amount of cash
- Social Security card, if applicable
- Plane tickets, if applicable
- Form I-766, "Employment Authorization Document," (EAD), if applicable
- Any medication that is critical to your health
- Take any contact numbers or email addresses with you so you can contact your designated school officials (DSOs) or responsible officers (ROs).
- Talk to a PDSO/DSO or Housing Director to find out how you should contact them if you must evacuate.
- Take the SEVP contact information with you. If you cannot get in touch with your PDSO/DSO, contact SEVP to let them know where you are and how to reach you. Email at SEVP@ice.dhs.gov, or call at (703) 603-3400.
- If you decide to transfer to a different school, call (703) 603-3400 to determine if the new school is SEVP-certified, and then contact Student Services to obtain the Transfer Out form.
