

# CERTIFICATE IN COLLEGE STUDIES The LEAP Program

The LEAP (Leading to Education and Advanced Preparation) program is available to dual credit/early entry high school students. Students must have approval from their high school administrator. By completing the LEAP program, students will receive a Certificate in College Studies alongside their high school diploma.

#### **Benefits**

- Time Savings Students can save a year of college coursework
- Cost Savings Only \$142.76/credit (students that qualify for the Bank of ND Scholarship can receive free tuition for two classes per year)
- Flexible Delivery Students can take this program completely online or through a combination of online, face-to-face, and ITV delivery
- **Transferability** The general education courses in this program will transfer to other colleges in the North Dakota University System
- College Advisor Assistance in developing individualized academic plan

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
