




Caution: The Get Transcript Service is for individual taxpayers to retrieve their own transcripts for their own purposes. Use by any other entities is prohibited.

You can get various Form 1040-series <u>transcript types</u> online or by mail. If you need your prior year **Adjusted Gross Income** (**AGI**) to e-file, choose the *tax return transcript* type when making your request. To find out how much you owe or to verify your payment history, you can view your tax account.

The method you used to file your tax return, e-file or paper, and whether you had a balance due, affects your <u>current year</u> transcript availability. **Note:** If you need a photocopy of your return, you must use Form 4506.
