Tuberculosis Screening Form

All students born outside of the U.S. are required to fill out the Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Form and return it to Student Services

<u>If you answer yes</u> to any of the questions in Part B, Mantoux skin testing, a T-Spot or Quantiferon Gold blood test is required. Documentation of results from a physician must be obtained prior to admissions being complete. If you have tested positive, documentation of a negative chest x-ray will be needed. All students with a current positive test result must have doctor's recommendation for treatment. <u>If you answered "None of the following apply" then you do not need to do TB testing.</u>
