Research consultations are pre-scheduled appointments where you work one-on-one with a librarian; they are designed for students, faculty, and staff who have longer-term, more in-depth research projects.

Research consultations can be scheduled Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. only. Please allow 24-48 hours for a librarian to respond to your request and schedule the consultation.

Schedule a research consultation when:

- You have at least a week or more before your project is due.
- You already have a defined topic approved by your professor.
- You have started your research and have a working bibliography.
- You have already consulted a librarian and need more in-depth assistance.
- You need help finding specialized resources, such as archival materials.
