Subject: Request for Students not to return to Campus after Spring Break

Good afternoon,

We have received several requests from students asking if they could return to the campus after spring break. Based on information from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the North Dakota Department of Health, and the Governor's Office, we are asking DCB students **not to return to the college** or the Bottineau community at this time. This is necessary to limit the spread of COVID-19. Also, any student returning to the campus during the COVID-19 Pandemic will need to undergo an immediate COVID-19 screening before entering any campus building and would likely be quarantined for a minimum of 14 days.

Please understand that these precautions are necessary to protect the health of all students and staff. As all classes during the spring semester will be available in an online/alternative delivery format, it is not necessary for students to be on campus to complete their coursework. Support services will also be available via online and distance technologies.
