Policy on Finishing Courses Remotely

Students who enroll in a course which is delivered in a face-to-face and/or IVN format will be required to complete the entire course in a face-to-face and/or IVN format. Technologies which allow students to connect to the face-to-face/IVN classroom remotely are only to be used in extraordinary circumstances (e.g. quarantine or isolation as it relates to a pandemic, medical emergencies, death of a family member, college sponsored activities, campus or distance site closure, etc.). Extraordinary circumstances do not include voluntarily electing to depart campus prior to the completion of the academic term. Students who believe they have extraordinary circumstance which qualifies them to finish a face-to-face/IVN course remotely, should contact the Associate Dean for Academic and Student Affairs to initiate the request to finish one or more courses remotely.
