The Dakota College at Bottineau Associate of Arts (AA) in Art provides students with the basic general education in two-dimensional design, drawing and art appreciation, as well as critical thinking that is needed to be successful in other academic and professional careers.

The art program, with offerings in studio art and independent projects, encourages students to broaden their knowledge and gain experience beyond foundational coursework. As a general education elective, art coursework is transferable to any four-year program in art at another university.

Why study art?

Creative thinking is a requirement of most professional careers and is essential to personal growth. Coursework in art at Dakota College enhances the student's ability to apply creative solutions to practical life situations and to communicate effectively. Through continued practice of studio principles students learn discipline, self-determination and perceptual skills that translate into other coursework.

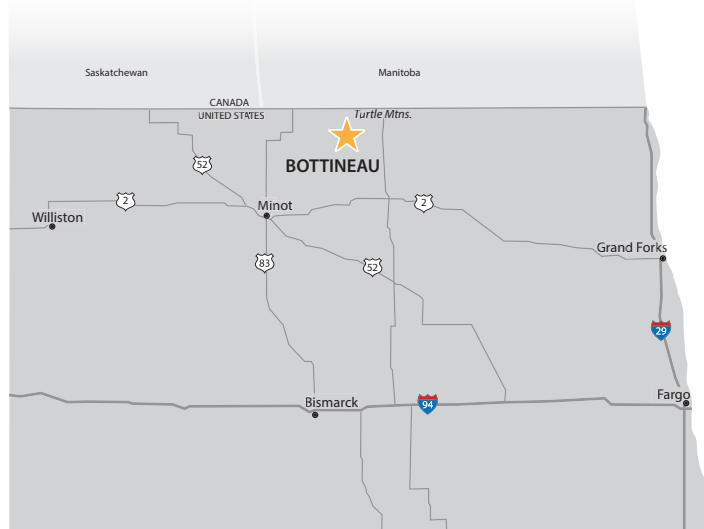
