The biology program at DCB provides a general education component along with several electives in the biological sciences leading to an Associate of Science degree. The curriculum is designed to prepare students to subsequently pursue a bachelor's degree in the biological sciences.

Why study biology?

Earning a degree in biology prepares students for careers in teaching or research in biology, botany, entomology, microbiology, and natural resource management. A bachelor's degree in biology also prepares graduates to go on to professional programs in medicine, dentistry, optometry, physical therapy and veterinary medicine.

Career choices

Professionals with their biology AS who transfer on and complete a bachelor's, master's and/or Ph.D. can have a variety of careers. Some examples include:

- Wildlife biologist

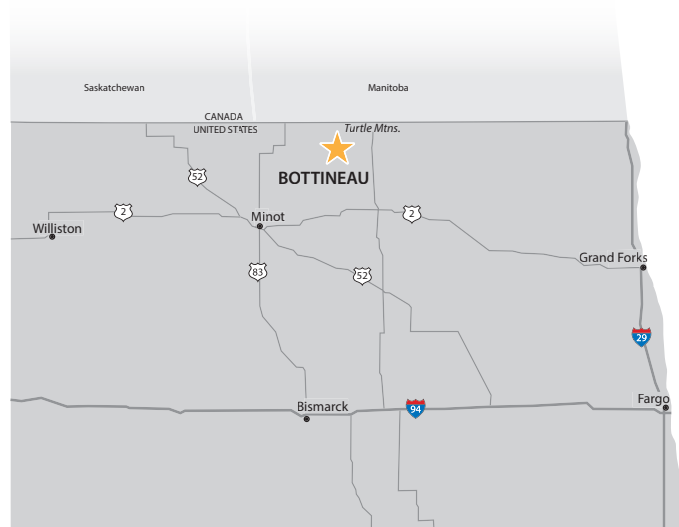
